Connect your unit with the system components according to the description on the following pages.





[Figure 1.1 Front panel]




[Figure 1.2 Rear panel]


[Figure 2.1 UTP CAT-5 cable connection ]

### **Operations**

- 1. You can press zone selection button Z1 to Z4 for individual zone announcement.
- 2. The selected zone LED should be turned on. If you want to remove selected zone, press same zone button one more time.
- 3. "CHIME" button allow to play pre-announcement chime.
- 4. Press and hold the "TALK" button while you announce to selected zone.
- 5.All of zone selection buttons doesn't work when the locking switch located "LOCK" position.
- 6. Output level can be controlled by rear volume.
